Wirral St. John s ospice - Christmas.

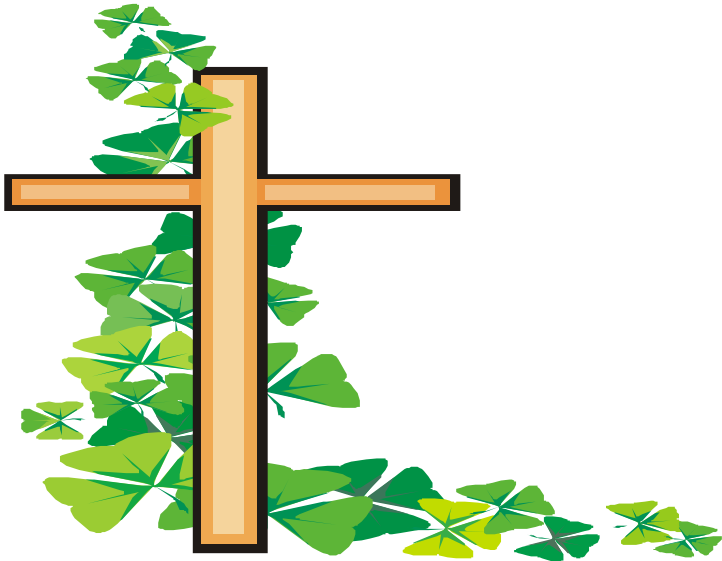
Christmas cards, calendars and diaries will be for sale in the Church Foyer from this Sunday until the middle of November. All proceeds go to the Hospice.
